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STOP in the historic **Brooke Street precinct** (Calder Highway A79), 185km north west of Melbourne and 45km north west of Bendigo. Gold was discovered here in 1859 and the town became known as 'The city in the scrub'.





SHOP in one of the eclectic **vintage and collectable stores**, our good old fashioned Op Shop and various specialty stores along Brooke Street. Call in at the unique **Eucalyptus Distillery Museum** at the northern edge of town. Eucalyptus oil production was a mainstay industry here for many years following the gold rush.

STAY a little longer to enjoy the slower pace and wide, open spaces. Take time away from the hustle and bustle to leisurely explore Inglewood and the surrounding towns in our region.





SEE the gold rush era buildings and the legacy bestowed by architect William Charles Vahland. Take in the sights and sounds of Kooyoora State Park and Melville Caves, a short drive from town.

SAVOUR a great coffee or a hearty meal in town. With welcoming cafés and hotel/s offering varied menus, there's plenty to enjoy. Visit the local butcher, home of Inglewood Aged Beef or stop by the IGA supermarket to stock up on quality provisions.
